## Coronavirus arrangements update: Advanced notice of partial closure

Whilst we have been trying to minimise the impact of Coronavirus on our staffing and the normal operations of our school, the updated "stay at home" guidance (see link below) is now having a significant impact on my ability to run the school both safely and securely.

We have today witnessed a significant increase in the number of staff who are now self-isolating and this trend of reduction of staffing availability is likely to increase, as we head through this week. Reluctantly, we have reached the conclusion that we can no longer keep the school open to all students.

We must therefore reduce the number of students in school. As a result, on Thursday 19th March and Friday, 20th March 2020, the school will be closed to students in Years 7, 8 and 9. Students in these year groups must stay at home. Please encourage them to access work via the google classroom and other online platforms that they will be familiar with in school; Doddle and Seneca for example. It is important to try to continue with a routine in these unsettled times. We will endeavour to provide work, but please appreciate our reduced staffing levels.

Our current plan is to give priority to students in Years 10 - 13 who are currently preparing for GCSE and A level examinations this summer.














