Dear parent/carer,

We hope this email finds you well.

We wanted to contact you to inform you that following the government announcement yesterday (15th June) that moving to stage 4 on the road map has been delayed by four weeks, we unfortunately have to cancel the Year 11 prom that was due to be held on the 22nd June 2021. However, we have made contact with Woolston Manor today and have now been offered the alternative date - **Monday 19th July 2021**.

It must be noted that this date is also subject to the government restrictions being lifted on the 19th July. However, should it be cancelled again, you will be given a full refund on a ticket/s purchased.

We obviously still want to give our Year 11 cohort a leavers experience whilst following government guidance, so we will be converting to our 'Plan B' which was explained in the previous communication sent out to parents. A reminder of the details are below;

Tuesday 22nd June 2021

- Students arrive at the Sports Hall entrance at **9.20am** in school uniform - please ensure your child's uniform is impeccable. They do not need to wear their blazer, but all other uniform expectations remain as normal, notably appropriate length skirts.
- Students will be given time to sign shirts, take photos and say their farewells.
- Weather permitting, we will hold an outdoor assembly.
- Students will be released from approximately **10.45am**.
- **There will be no Prom in the evening - now 'hopefully' to be held Monday 19th July.**
