Gates will not not open until 5 minutes before their expected arrival time and students should not arrive too early and congregate, to respect our local community. ## All students are expected to attend full time and aim for 100% attendance.

You can expect to hear from us if your child's attendance falls below 96%. It is important to understand that if your child achieves 96% attendance at the end of an academic year, they will still have missed 8 full days of education. If your child's attendance falls below 90% attendance they will have missed a whole 19 days of education. We are obligated to take legal action against families who have poor attendance. ### **Summer 2022 Public Examinations**

Ofqual are currently consulting on the arrangements for the summer 2022 exam series. We have some guidance around the reduction in requirements for practical subjects such as Art, Music, PE and Drama. However, the decision around subjects such as English Literature, Geography, History at GCSE won't be confirmed until the start of the autumn term. Maths, Physics and Combined Science will have support materials provided which has been suggested will be in the form of a formula sheet - this will also be confirmed in September 2021.
