Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you that the last day of your son/daughter's formal education is Friday 20th May. However, the arrangements for week commencing Monday 16th May will vary as there are exams throughout this week.

Monday 16th May - Normal school day (Some students will have exams in the morning and/or afternoon)

Tuesday 17th May - Biology in the morning followed by preparation for the English Exam on Wednesday 18th. This session will end at 1.20pm and students will be allowed to leave at lunch. There will be some targeted online sessions starting at 2.00pm

Wednesday 18th May - English Language Exam in the morning followed by normal lessons

Thursday 19th May - Normal School day (Drama students will have an exam in the afternoon)

Friday 20th May - Maths exam in the morning and Business in the afternoon. Students who don't take Business will be free to leave the site after the exam. Final Preparation for the Business exam will take place prior to the afternoon exam.

For the week beginning Monday 23rd May, there will be a number of targeted sessions offered to students to assist them in their exam preparation. Students will only come to school when they have an exam or to attend a revision class. All classes for which your son/daughter still has exams to sit will run as normal on a 'skeleton' timetable. If your son/daughter is attending a class they must sign in at Student Reception. If they have an exam, they do not need to sign in and out as this will be done for them when we take a register in the exam venue.

After Half Term (from week commencing 6th June), students will be invited in for revision sessions in preparation for forthcoming exams. Details of which will be shared closer to the time.

Please note, all these days are completely normal days for year 11 students and should not be treated as a 'last day' - there should be no shirt signing for example or behaviour that will disrupt the rest of the school. We have a morning dedicated to shirt signing and an assembly planned specifically at the end of the exam season so everyone can relax. If any student entertains any early celebrations, they run the risk of not being invited in for the assembly or Prom.

We hope to keep all students with us in school until the formal study leave period begins; however, if students are behaving in a way that is having a negative impact on their own progress, or that of their peers, in these last few weeks we may be forced to ask them to work from home and only attend when they have an exam. If this is the case and they do find themselves on early study leave, they will not be invited to join the celebrations at the end of the examination period which includes the Leavers' Assembly, shirt signing and the Prom. Please understand we are running out of time in the lead up to the summer exam season, therefore we will not tolerate students who fail to follow simple instructions and misbehave or pick and choose what they wish to attend. We need all students on board doing the right thing at the right time in order to secure the best possible results for everyone. If someone is letting themselves down we will ask them to work from home. We will not be issuing warnings. It will be a straight forward decision and all students will be told this.



Leavers' Assembly (29th June 2022)

- Students arrive at the Sports Hall entrance at 9.20am in school uniform - please ensure your child's uniform is impeccable. They do not need to wear their blazer, but all other uniform expectations remain as normal, notably appropriate length skirts.
- There will be an opportunity for photos and signing of shirts before assembly starts at 9.45am.
- Students will leave school at approximately 10.45am
- We have been in close communication with the local policing team who are keen for us to remind students not to congregate in large groups as they leave the school site on this day.

Prom (29th June 2022)

- Students to arrive at Woolston Manor from 7.00pm
- In line with the security and safety expectations of the venue, all students will be searched on arrival.
- Once inside the venue, students must remain inside. If a student leaves the venue, even just to go to their awaiting limousine in the car park, they will not be allowed back into the venue.
- Please ensure you inform us of any special dietary requirements or allergies when purchasing your son/daughter's Prom ticket.
- The Prom will finish at 11.00pm - please ensure that you have organised travel arrangements for your child's journey home. In the past it has been very difficult for local taxi companies to pick up any last-minute bookings, so please ensure this is pre-arranged if you are not collecting them personally.

Tickets are £30 and include: a 'red carpet reception', a buffet, security and entertainment.

Students will need to purchase their own 'soft' drinks at the venue. We have booked a photographer for the evening, and a link will be sent to you after the event for you to choose and order your pictures.

The prom is a formal attire event and therefore no trainers and as with all school events, normal school behaviour expectations apply.

Tickets are available to purchase via ParentPay.

Year 11 lockers must be emptied by Friday 24th June 2022 and padlocks should be returned to student reception. Any belongings left behind after this will be taken to lost property. After two weeks, anything that has not been claimed will be disposed of.

Please find below a copy of the generic summer exam timetable. Your son/daughter has of course been issued with their own individual one via Edulink. Students must refer to their own individual timetable for times and dates – there are a number of students with special arrangements this year due to clashes. Just a reminder – all morning exams will be preceded by a Breakfast Revision session starting at 8.20am in the Canteen. Breakfast and a drink will be provided. It is essential that every student attend all of their exams. Should you require any additional help with exam dates or procedures please do not hesitate to contact our Exams Officer, Mr Hall, on the usual school telephone number.
