Travel Plans



Details of travel are yet to be confirmed by the Tour Operator - detailed itinerary will be available next week with departure and arrival times

- We expect to leave early on Monday 13th February and arrive at Disneyland Paris early evening around 7 pm
- Visit the park on Tuesday and Wednesday
- Departure time is expected to be around 3 pm on Wednesday 15th February and expected to arrive back late at night at around 11 pm
- Students should only need a single piece of luggage and a smaller bag for valuables

Travel Documents

All students will need to have

- completed medical consent form
- a valid passport, expiry date no sooner than 16th August 2023
- Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)

France Entry Requirements

- Passport
- No food when crossing borders. Some conflicting and strange requirements
 - Apple's not allowed but banana's are okay
 - No meat or dairy products but you are allowed up to 20 kg of fish?
- No more COVID restrictions!!
 - Exceptions may apply and new rules can come into force at short notice

Students will need to buy their own lunches

- Restaurant prices are up to €30 per day but some places as little as €15
- Students may also wish to purchase food whilst travelling at service stations

Spending Money

We suggest €40-60 and around £20 to cover meals

You may wish to give more for souvenirs at your discretion, chocolates can be brought back to the UK!

Students will need to look after their park tickets. If it goes missing, we may need to call parents to purchase new park tickets





Safety

We will be purchasing hoodies for all students for safeguarding reasons

When unsupervised, students are expected to remain in groups of four or more

 They will also be expected to wear their hoodies whilst travelling and at the park

The weather is expected to be cold so warm clothing is advised with appropriate footwear



Mobile Phones

- Students will be provided with a school mobile phone number
 - This should be stored on their phone and kept written on their persons at all times in case of emergency
 - This number will be shared with parents as well
 - WhatsApp group for students
 - USB battery charger
- Free roaming has ended with all major UK mobile providers. Please be aware of any additional costs that may apply
